**WARRANT FOR THE ANNUAL MEETING
MAY 8, 2014**

TO: Armand H. Dimo, Acting Clerk of the Warren Water District, Warren, Massachusetts.

GREETINGS: In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the Warren Water District that are qualified to vote in the District affairs to meet in the Library of the Quaboag High School, 284 Old West Brookfield Rd., Warren, Massachusetts on Thursday, May 8, 2014 at seven o'clock in the evening to act on the following Articles.

- FIRST: To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
- SECOND: To hear reports of the District Officers and act thereon.
- THIRD: To elect the following officer by ballot, VIS:
One Water Commissioner to hold office for the term of three years.
- FOURTH: To see if the District will vote to authorize the Treasurer with the approval of the Commissioners to borrow money from time to time in anticipation of the revenue of the financial year beginning July 1, 2014 in accordance with the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 4, and to issue a note or notes therefore, for a period of less than one year in accordance with General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 17, or take any action relative thereto.
- FIFTH: To see if the District will vote to fix salary and compensation of elected officers of the District as provided by General Laws, Section 108, Chapter 41, as amended and raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds such sums of money as may be necessary to defray the expense of the District for the ensuing year or take action relative thereto.
- SIXTH: To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds a sum of money to the Retirement Assessment Account or take any action relative thereto.
- SEVENTH: To see if the District will vote to add a by-law to impose a fine for non-compliance with annual calibration of commercial meters or take any action relative thereto.
- EIGHTH: To see if the District will vote to add a by-law to impose a monthly fine for non-compliance to the electronic meter replacement policy or take any action relative thereto.


And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies thereof in at least two public places in the District not less than seven days prior to the day of the meeting.
