7:30pm-Remand Public Hearing on Special Permit No. 281 & Site Plan No. 49 for Syncarpha Capital LLC. The Applicant is requesting to construct and operate a 4.98 MW Ground-Mounted Solar Energy Facility. The Property is located on Little Rest Rd. also known as Assessors Map 11 Lots 82 & 83.3 which is located in the Rural District.

Carter McCann spokesmen for Syncarpha and Stephen O'Connell for Andrews Survey & Engineering, Inc. (ASE).

Mr. McCann discussed the main concerns the Abutters had with stormwater run-off. Mr. McCann showed on the Plans what precautions they have taking to keep the water on site not to run on to abutters properties or into the wetlands. Syncarpha will have cameras to monitor the Site.

Weekly reports will be giving to the Board. Graves will visit the Site weekly.

Discussion that the Town could possibly receive \$ 45,000.00 in Tax Revue also, a scholarship in the amount of \$40,000. To mitigate against potential impact on the abutters, Syncarpha has agreed to and shall perform and permit the following.

For the Blakes, utility lines shall be installed underground, not on poles. Employ additional dust control measures beyond the required state law including extra water and a plastic or geofabric barrier to be mounted on the Blakes property driveway entrance. Screen electrical utility boxes with a wood fence and tree planting. Will allow the Blakes to access the rear of their property via the new site driveway.

For the Trombly, to install 150 feet of trees to screen them from the Site.

For the Pontbriand, will plant a row of tree to screen the Site only if the Conservation Commission approves.

For the Beaudry, agreed to drill an artesian well.
