WARREN PLANNING BOARD MINUTES OF February 24, 2020

Meeting was called to order at 7:17 PM in the Selectman's Meeting Room

The Pledge of Allegiance

Discussion with Borrego seeking a field change.

Tabled since Borrego did not attend.

Discussion on Wavier for Sunpin Solar Development, LLC

Public Hearing for Special Permit No. 293 & Site Plan No.60 for Sunpin Solar Development, LLC. The Applicant is requesting to construct and operate a Ground-Mounted Solar Installation. The Property is owned by Richard & Madelyn Monaco and is located at 170 Brookfield Rd also known as Assessors Map 12 Lots 32 & 35 located in the Rural District. A copy of the application may be inspected in the Office of the Planning Board or Town Clerks Office during normal business hours.

Abutters notification and publication was done in accordance with the provision of Chapter 40A, 11 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

Stephen Borgotti, William Barley and Jim Martin ESQ Representatives for Sunpin.

Waiver filed with Site Plan dated June 19, 2019 asked for Five (5) requirements to be Waivered.

- 1. Site Plan Scale. Scale is 1'' = 40' wavier asked for 1'' = 80'. Board allow top sheet to be 1'' = 80' but remaining sheets 1'' = 40' so details will be easier to see.
- 2. Show location of buildings wavier asked to omit the elevation of the building. The Plans show where the buildings are but not the dimensions. The Board would like the dimensions on the plans.
- 3. Provide volume of earth removed. Decision that the applicant will come back to the Board prior to removal of any materials.
- 4. Waive 150' vegetative screening buffer. Question asked if the site will be seen by the abutters. Answer, parts of the Array will be seen (fencing, panels) one abutter will have more of a view of the site (2 in Brimfield). Mr. Veliz would like the buffer to remain so the trees and vegetation in the buffer will absorb some of the water runoff

from the trees that will be cleared for the Array. Mr. Dufresne stated this part of the Zoning By-laws was amended in 2019 by the Towns Residents and feels the Board should not wavy the buffer.

5. Identity of system installer. The installer will need to be identify at the time of permitting with the building inspector.

Discussion with Copart on possible expansion.

Patrick Secra, Keith Terry and David Berson representative for Copart.

Copart's will be filing a Special Permit, Site Plan Review and a Finding. to the Board for expansion of their Business.

Copart's owns Map 15 Lots 47, 47.1 and 52, 54 and recently inquired the Abutting Properties Map 16 Lots 7, 3 and 4. Copart's would like to expand to include parcels 15-52, 54 & 16-7 and possibly a small portion of 16-3 & 4.

The business is mainly a storage lot for auction vehicles, the vehicles are checked in on parcel 15-47.1 then moved to the storage lots. The vehicles are remaining on the lot longer for various reasons causing more volume of vehicles. Increase of traffic should be minimal. The Board would like a Traffic Survey.

Concerns with the delivery driver (speeding through Town and on Old West Warren Road taking up most of the Road) Leaking fluids from damaged vehicle seeping into the ground contaminated wells in the area.

The Board would like a tour of the facility once the applications are filed and Public Hearing is scheduled. Copart's welcomes the Board to visit.

Other Business

Discussion on possible article for May Town Meeting.

The Board will have a Workshop Meeting on March 16, 2020 to propose changes to the Solar By-Laws.
