

FY 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Application

Public Hearing Notice

The Warren Board of Selectmen will conduct a public hearing regarding its proposed FY 2021 application to the Massachusetts Community Development Block Grant Program. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, August 26, 2021, at 6:00 p.m.** in the Selectmen's Meeting Room at the Shepard Municipal Building located at 48 High Street, Warren, MA.

The grant application will seek funds for public works improvements to School Street. This project was identified as a priority based on previous planning and engineering studies that determined the street needs comprehensive rehabilitation including the potable water mains, sewer repairs, retaining wall structural upgrades, drainage system improvements, new curbing, and road and sidewalk reconstruction. This proposed grant, if funded, is intended to focus on the subsurface infrastructure, most notably the replacement of the potable water line, as well as the rehabilitation and replacement of a large retaining wall supporting the street and sidewalk.

All persons with questions or comments regarding the grant application will have an opportunity to be heard. If awarded, the Town of Warren will be responsible for administration of the grant program with assistance from the Central Massachusetts Regional Planning Commission (CMRPC). Those unable to attend the hearing may mail written comments to the Warren Board of Selectmen, 48 High Street, P.O. Box 609, Warren, MA 01083, or comments may be emailed to CMRPC at cdunphy@pvpc.org. Comments must be received no later than August 31, 2021.

The Shepard Municipal Building is accessible to disabled persons.
