Use of the Public Sewer

1. All sewer connections are governed by the Town of Warren Sewer Use Regulations.
2. No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any stormwater, surface water, groundwater, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, uncontaminated cooling water, or unpolluted industrial process waters to any sanitary sewer.
3. No water from pools, reservoirs or cellars shall be drained into any sanitary sewer either by gravity or by pumping.
4. Contractor is required to review sewer system plans at plant and submit connection plan for review by the Warren Sewer Department Superintendent or Representative at this time.
5. No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any of the following described waters or wastes to any public sewer inlet or manhole:
 - Any gasoline, benzene, naphtha, fuel oil, or other flammable or explosive liquid, solid or gas.
