## Use of the Public Sewer

- 1. All sewer connections are governed by the Town of Warren Sewer Use Regulations.
- 2. No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any stormwater, surface water, groundwater, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, uncontaminated cooling water, or unpolluted industrial process waters to any sanitary sewer.
- 3. No water from pools, reservoirs or cellars shall be drained into any sanitary sewer either by gravity or by pumping.
- 4. Contractor is required to review sewer system plans at plant and submit connection plan for review by the Warren Sewer Department Superintendent or Representative at this time.
- 5. No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any of the following described waters or wastes to any public sewer inlet or manhole:
  - Any gasoline, benzene, naptha, fuel oil, or other flammable or explosive liquid, solid or gas.
