Responsibilities:

- Follow all rules and regulations
- Guide individual(s) and groups in participating in recreational activities
- Supervise all aspects of the participants' day
- Assist teaching or leading activities as assigned
- Maintain good public relations with participants and parents
- Set a good example for participants and others; including cleanliness, punctuality, sharing, clean-up, and sportsmanship
- Other duties may be assigned as required
